

ASBESTOS EXPOSURE Suggested Clinical Evaluation Process

All workers who have been exposed to asbestos should be made aware that asbestos can affect one's gastrointestinal tract, including throat, stomach, large bowel, pancreas and kidney. Females should be made aware that asbestos exposure may be associated with ovarian cancer. The worker's treating physician should be made aware of the fact that the worker had exposures to asbestos in the past in order that they may have appropriate investigations for these organs.

All workers exposed to asbestos should be strongly advised to discontinue smoking.
