Re: Possible Exposure to Asbestos

Recent School Board reports indicate that asbestos-containing vermiculite has been spilling into the workplace. I am concerned about the possibility of long-term exposure to asbestos in my workplace. I will be completing and submitting a Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) Worker's Exposure Incident Form. The form will be registered with the Program for Exposure Incident Reporting (PEIR) at the WSIB.

Please record in my medical file that I have been exposed to asbestos in my workplace, and that I am concerned about the long term effects of this exposure.

Medical, smoking, exposure history and physical exam are recommended at this time. Health effects have a long latency (>10 years). On the back, you will see an algorithm outlining current testing recommendations.
